Orrin Weeman, of Captain *Edward Collins* Company, (E,) of the *Seventh Mass* Regiment of United States Infantry, was enlisted by *Capt Edward Collins*, of the *7th Mass* Regiment of *U.S. Infantry*, at *Dorchester Mass* on the *third* day of *May*, 1861, to serve *three* years; he was born in *Hiram* in the State of *Maine*, is *Twenty* years of age, *five* feet *seven* inches high, *light* complexion, *hazel* eyes, *brown* hair, and by occupation when enlisted a *Shoemaker*. During the last two months said soldier has been unfit for duty *twenty* days. (Here consult directions on Form 12, p. 269, Medical Dept. Gen. Reg.)
