Private Daniel Dunn of Captain Rockwood Company, (A) of the 15th Regiment of United States was enlisted by Capt Rockwood of the 15th Regiment of Mass at Lunenburg on the 7th day of May 1861, to serve 3 years; he was born in St. Johns in the State of New Brunswick is 45 years of age, 5 feet 6 inches high, Dark complexion, Dark eyes, Dark hair, and by occupation when enlisted a Hais Horse Man.
